CIS Dance Fest 2018-19 Workshop Descriptions

HIP-HOP

Hip-Hop dance refers to street dance styles evolved as part of hip-hop culture. It includes a wide range of styles such as Breaking, House, Krump, Popping, and Locking.

Beginner Hip-Hop Guest Teacher Malcolm Messado has worked for Artists such as En Vogue, Ariana Grande, Avril Lavigne, July Talk, Anastasia A, Classified, Electric Ave, Rebel Coast, Meaghen Smith, Thugli, Cascada, and Audio Playground as well as TV/Film projects for Disney's Zombies, YTV, Lifetime, Much Music/M₃, CTV, Raptors, Rogers, Spotify, and TIFF.

Intermediate/ Advanced Hip-Hop Guest Teacher Shavar "Caution" Blackwood was featured as Top 14 spot on Season 3 of "So You Think You Can Dance Canada" and was a featured dancer in the Lifetime movie "Aaliyah The Princess of R&B". He danced in the Family Channel show "Naturally Sadie" and performed with artists such as Cascada, Mcfly, George Nozuka, Divine Brown, and Jacksoul.

CONTEMPORARY

Contemporary dance is a style of expressive dance that combines elements of several dance genres including modern, jazz, lyrical and classical ballet.

Guest Teacher Samantha Raymond's credits include: dancing in the Middle East with Creativiva's production of 'Pinocchio', travelling to Greece to perform in the Women in War project with director Peggy Shannon, and dancing alongside Emilio Colallilo at Fresh Blood Choreographic Festival 2013. Here the duo received the Paula Citron award for outstanding choreography with their piece, 'Avidita'.

Brazilian Dance (Samba)

Samba is a Brazilian dance form that was created by African people in Brazil who brought much of their music and dance culture into Latin America with them upon arrival into many Latin American countries.

Guest Teacher Nick Tull's Theatrical credits include: TV shows produced by Warner Brothers, Nickelodeon, Nickelodeon Germany, Universal Studios, Paramount Canada's Wonderland, Slice TV, Bacardi, Mercedes Benz Jully Black, Rogers, HBC, various recording artists such as Aleesia, Shawn Desman, Victoria Duffield, Lloyd Banks, Euro Super Groups and artists like US5, Lexington Bridge, Jimi Blue.
